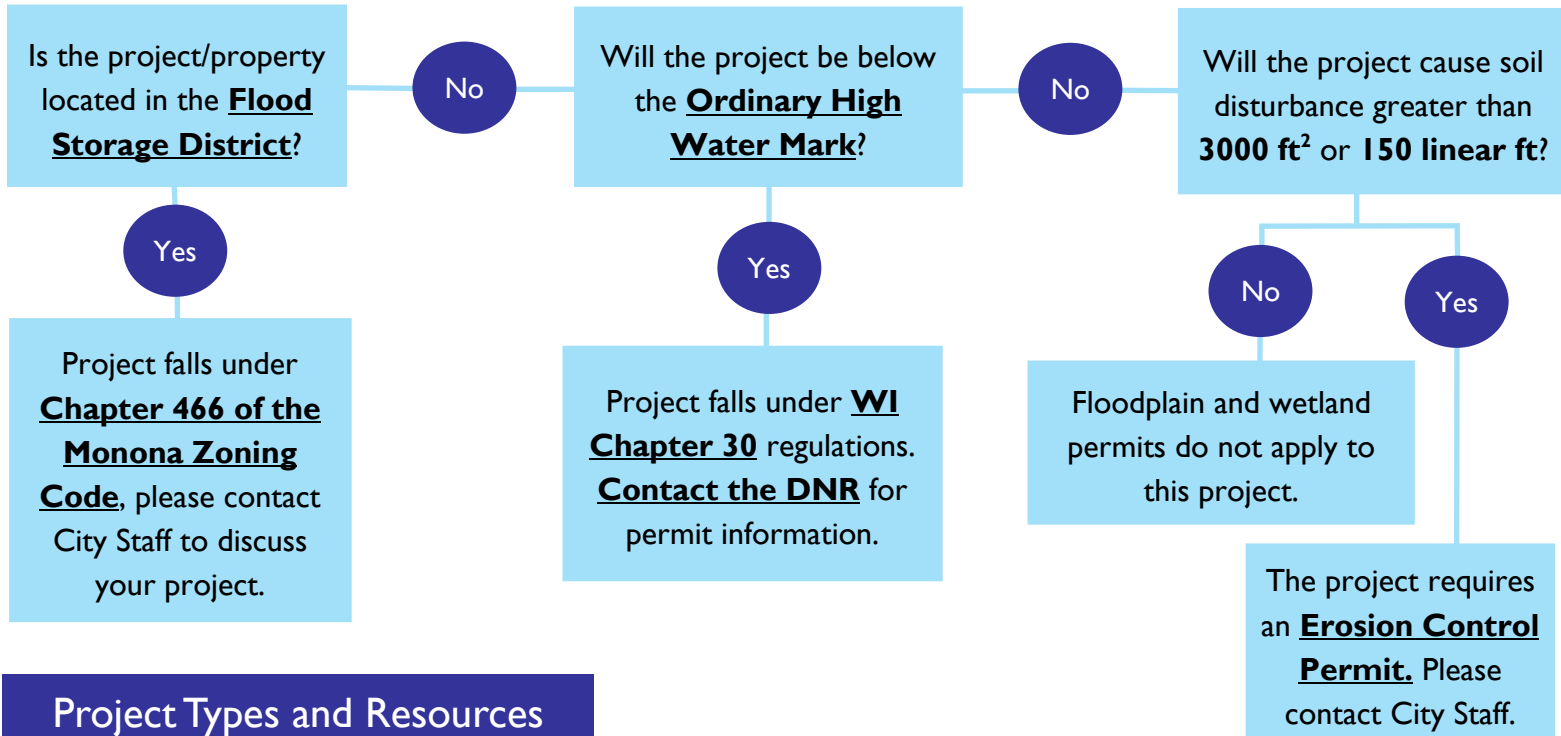


Understanding Monona's Floodplain and Shoreline Regulations
