At this open house & workshop You will be asked to:

- Assist in defining goals and objectives for the pedestrian and bicycle plan.
- Identify areas where pedestrian and bicycle improvements are needed.
- Tell us about your experiences walking or biking in Monona.

Did you know that:

- From 2011-15 in Dane County there were 798 documented motor vehicle crashes involving bicyclists and 552 crashes involving pedestrians.
- Over 60% of pedestrians involved in crashes were in a marked or unmarked crosswalk at the time of the collision.
- Pedestrian injuries are the leading cause of unintentional injury related deaths for children 5 to 14 years old.
- Only 17% of students walk or bike to school (compared with 71% of adults who walked to school as children).
- In Dane County 8% of all pedestrian crashes are pedestrians 65 years or older and 3% of all bicyclist crashes are bikers 65 years or older.
