



Single Stream Recycling

With single-stream recycling you do not have to sort your recyclables. You can just mix everything together! The following materials go in the carts:

- Cardboard and mixed paper including newspaper, phone books, beverage cases, cereal boxes, computer and copy paper, junk mail, magazines, file folders, and steel/tin can labels.
- Plastics numbered 1-5 and 7 (rinsed clean) including 5-gallon pails (wire handles removed). No food take-out containers.
- Glass (rinsed clean), bottles and jars. No lids or window glass.
- Aluminum, steel, and tin cans (labels removed and rinsed clean).

Fully Automated Collection Service

Your New Collection Day will be TUESDAY or WEDNESDAY

Veolia Environmental Services is pleased to be your waste removal provider. Our goal is to provide you with a seamless transition to automated collection of your waste materials.



There are a few basic rules to follow under this automated collection system:

- Set your cart out by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- All items must fit in the cart, with lid closed.
- It is recommended that you bag shredded paper to ensure a cleaner collection of your recycling material.
- Do not put any hazardous or flammable materials in your cart as they could damage the cart.

Cart Placement is Key

Where and how you place your cart is very important. If the cart is obstructed by a car or other object we cannot collect them. Please follow these rules for cart placement:



- Place the carts at the end of your driveway. Do not put it in the street.
- Point the cart so the lid opening is facing the curb away from your house.
- Give the carts space. Please allow four feet between your recycle cart and other objects and six feet from parked cars on the street.

What if I have items that do not fit in the cart?
Your collection service is limited to what you can put in your cart. To ensure all your materials fit, the City of Monona has initiated the program using 64-gallon carts & 96 gallon carts.

For items that do not fit in the cart, please call (608) 251-7878.

Important Changes to Collection days-Please take note:

- Collection is reducing from 3 days to 2 days (Tuesday or Wednesday) per week, so your collection day may be changing. Please see the attached collection calendar and map for your collection day.
- Trash will be collected every week on your collection day.
- Recycling will continue to be collected every other week on your collection day. See the attached collection calendar and map for clarification of what week your recycling will be collected.

What about my Bulk Items and E-Waste?

- All bulk items and E-Waste will now be collected on the last Friday of the month.
- Bulk items includes things like Furniture, Appliances, Dehumidifiers, Microwaves, Water Heaters, etc...
- E-Waste includes TV's, Computers, Monitors, Printers, VCR's, Cell Phones, Cameras, etc...
- Collection requests will now be called in directly to Veolia, and no longer City Hall.
- Residents will set up collection of these items and pay Veolia directly.
