

**Ordinance No. 11-11-631
Monona Common Council**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL TRAFFIC MAP
CONCERNING NO PARKING ON COPPS AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Common Council previously established an Official Traffic Map pursuant to section 62.23(6) of the Wisconsin Statutes to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, due to poor visibility with vehicles parked too close to Copps Avenue business driveways and in sight lines of the Copps Avenue and Broadway Avenue intersection it makes it dangerous for bicyclists and motor vehicles to enter Copps Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, the new traffic signal loop detectors are installed in traffic lanes that in the past have been permitted for parking; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has recommended prohibiting parking on the west side of Copps Avenue to a point approximately 245 feet north from the Broadway Avenue intersection, and on the east side of Copps Avenue to a point approximately 225 feet north from the Broadway Avenue intersection; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Official Traffic Map to implement such a change; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the public hearing and recommendations of city staff, the Public Works Committee, the Common Council finds it in the public interest to amend the Official Traffic Map to reflect the change.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Monona, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Parking is hereby prohibited on Copps Avenue in the City of Monona as follows:

1. On the west side of Copps Avenue to a point approximately 245 feet north from the Broadway Avenue intersection, and on the east side of Copps Avenue to a point approximately 225 feet north from the Broadway Avenue intersection.

SECTION 2. The Official Traffic Map is hereby amended in conformity with Section 1 above.

SECTION 3. City staff is directed to take all action necessary to implement this ordinance, including the installation of appropriate signage consistent with practices specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

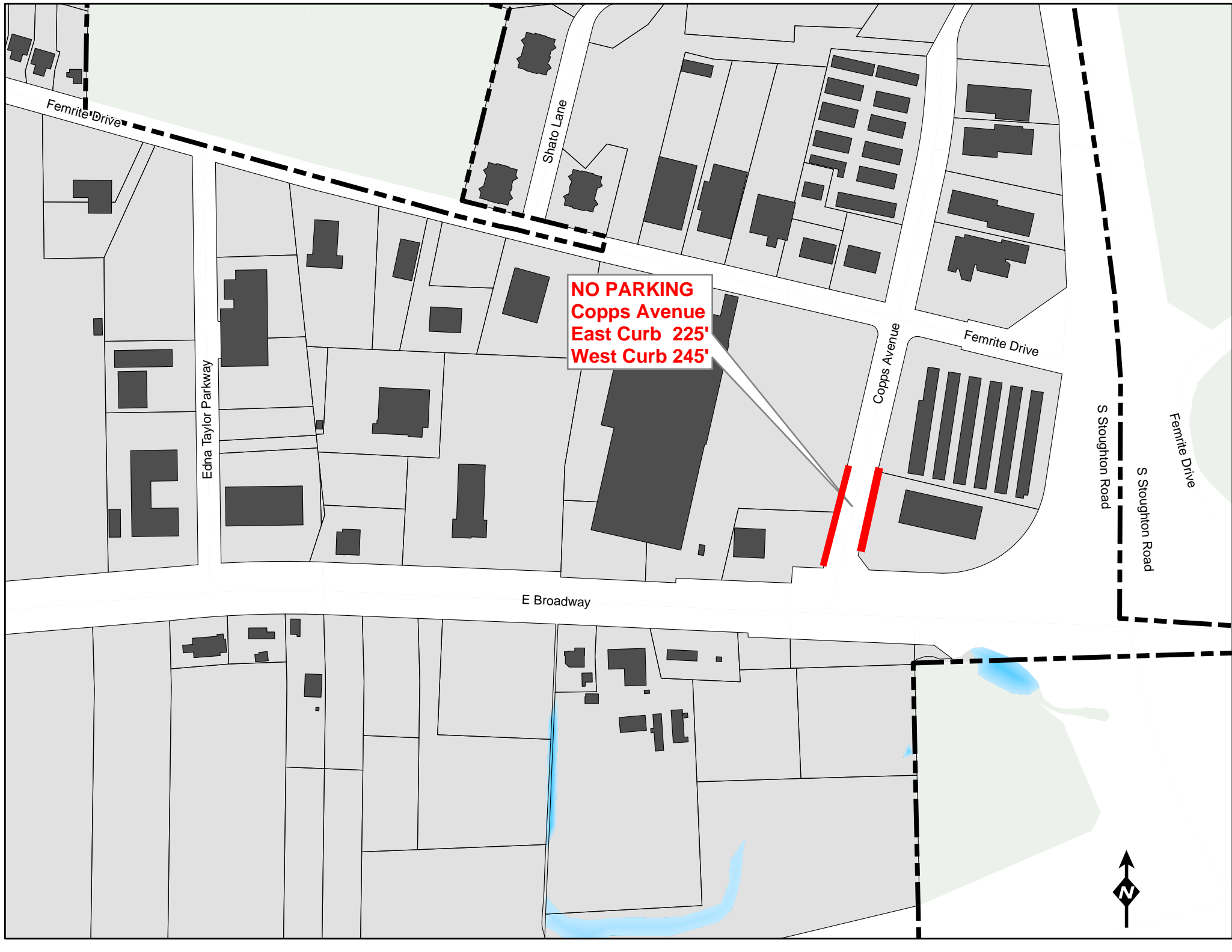
