**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL TRAFFIC MAP
CONCERNING NO PARKING ON WINNEQUAH ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Common Council previously established an Official Traffic Map pursuant to section 62.23(6) of the Wisconsin Statutes to protect the public health, safety, and welfare; and,

WHEREAS, the 5500 block of Winnequah Road is a heavily traveled road located on a curve where it intersects with the Winnequah Trail intersection; and,

WHEREAS, this busy intersection has many pedestrians and bicyclists traveling from the Winnequah Trail area to and from Winnequah Park; and,

WHEREAS, due to poor visibility with vehicles parked too close to Winnequah Trail it makes it dangerous for pedestrians, bicyclists and motor vehicles to cross this popular intersection; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Commission has recommended prohibiting parking on the south side of the 5500 block of Winnequah Road from a point approximately 30 feet southwest of the intersection of Winnequah Trail on Winnequah Road; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Official Traffic Map to implement such a change; and,

WHEREAS, based upon the public hearing and recommendations of city staff, the Public Safety Commission, and the Public Works Committee, the Common Council finds it in the public interest to amend the Official Traffic Map to reflect the change.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Monona, Dane County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Parking is hereby prohibited on Winnequah Road in the City of Monona as follows:

1. At all points along the south side of the 5500 Block of Winnequah Road from a point approximately 30 feet southwest of the intersection of Winnequah Trail.

SECTION 2. The Official Traffic Map is hereby amended in conformity with Section 1 above.

SECTION 3. City staff is directed to take all action necessary to implement this ordinance, including the installation of appropriate signage consistent with practices specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

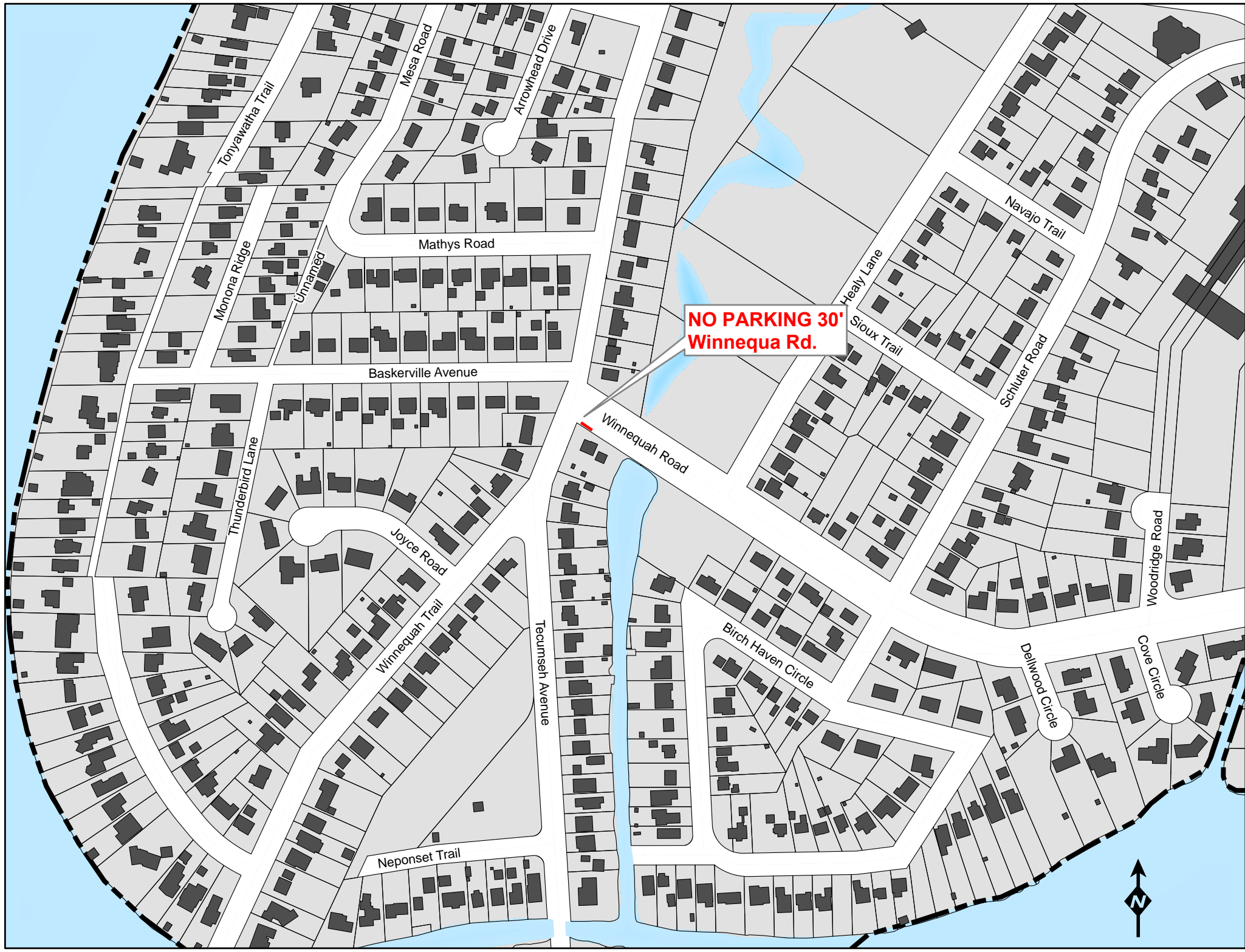
