

## FREE BRUSH COLLECTION DURING 2009

The schedule for the City of Monona free brush collection program for 2009 is as follows:

Brush should be placed at curbside in an orderly manner by 7:00 a.m. on Monday of the collection week. Once collection on a street is completed, crews will not return for additional brush removal.

Brush shall be cut and trimmed to the size for one person to safely handle. Limbs should not exceed six (6) inches in diameter and ten (10) feet in length. Thorny brush should be piled separate from other brush so as to minimize potential injury to collection personnel. Brush and other refuse must be kept separate at the curbside. Collection is not available for stumps, logs, or tree roots.

The free brush collection is provided for brush trimmed by the homeowner only. City ordinance states that collection is not available for brush trimmed by a private contractor. Brush generated through a private contractor is to be disposed of by the contractor.

Residents can also take brush to the Bruce Company compost facility on Meier Road, located off of Femrite Drive east of Highway 39/90/94. This facility is available 24/7.
