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No Transit: There is no bus service in Monona from our city or Madison.

Monona Express: The current commuter bus service with four loops AM and PM.

Monona Lift: The current service to support older adults in our community.

Metro C3 Route (One Way): The new route managed by Madison Metro Transit, going in one direction clockwise down Stoughton Rd and up through Monona.

Metro C3 Route (Two Way): The new route managed by Madison Metro Transit, going in two directions clockwise down Stoughton Rd and up through Monona, and also through Monona then up Stoughton Rd.

Metro G&L *with additional stops as offered by Metro*: The Metro routes G & L will make stops in Monona.
