## **ALA Conference Coach Tour**

Join fellow librarians and attend the American Library Association Annual Conference being held in Chicago, July 10-15, 2009. SCLS has contracted with Van Galder Bus for transportation to and from Chicago.

Our charter 56-passenger coach is equipped with a restroom, allowing us to drive directly to the McCormick Place from Madison. Please bring your own beverage and food needs for the morning trip. On the evening return trip, we will have the coach stop at a convenient fast food restaurant to allow you to purchase food. You will also want to plan for additional personal expenses while visiting the exhibits.

Registration is limited to SCLS public library members, including staff, trustees and Friends of the Library, and SCLS staff. If space permits, spouses, MALC member library staff, and members of other library systems are welcome. Priority will be given to SCLS member public library staff. Registration deadline is Monday, May 18, 2009.

Option 1: Saturday, July 11, 2009 OR Monday, July 13, 2009 (choose one)

- Transportation and Exhibits Only Pass (if registered by deadline)
- Cost: \$55 (includes transportation and Exhibits Pass)
- Departure time (Madison): 7:00 a.m. from SCLS Administration Offices, 5250 E. Terrace Drive, Madison
- Arrival Time (Chicago): approximately 10:00 a.m. at McCormick Place
- Departure Time (Chicago) (5:30 p.m. leave McCormick Place and arrive back in Madison between 8:30 and 9:00 p.m.
- SCLS will submit your ALA registration form for Exhibits Only passes if received by the deadline
  - Please complete page 2 and 3 of the <u>ALA Registration</u> form and return to Jean Anderson at SCLS. We will send in all Exhibits Only registrations as a group.
- Cancellations: Substitutions are welcome, but refunds are not available for Exhibits Only passes (this is an ALA policy). Please contact <u>Jean Anderson</u> if you need to cancel.

Option 2: Saturday, July 11, 2009 through Monday, July 13, 2009

- Transportation Only
- Cost: \$30 (does not include Exhibits Pass)
- Departure time (Madison): 7:00 a.m., Saturday, July 11 from SCLS Administration Offices, 5250 E. Terrace Drive, Madison
- Arrival time (Chicago): after dropping off Exhibits Only attendees, the bus will travel to a hotel (TBD) in downtown Chicago. From there, you will need to make your way to your hotel (a suitcase on wheels will be helpful here)
- Check with your hotel about early check-in or checking your luggage
- You are responsible for your ALA Conference registration and hotel reservations
- Departure Time (Chicago): 4:30 p.m., Monday, July 13, 2009 the bus will pick up attendees at the same hotel (TBD), then travel to the McCormick Place, pick up Exhibits Only attendees and depart at 5:30 p.m. The bus will arrive back in Madison between 8:39 and 9:00 p.m.

Please complete the <u>SCLS registration</u> form. <u>CE Grant</u> funds made be used to cover the cost. Please submit a CE Grant <u>application</u> before July 1, 2009.
